

- 1. Armed Police Force, Nepal Headquarters, Procurement Division invites **electronic** bids from eligible bidders for the procurement of Various Size of Tent under National competitive bidding Single Stage Two Envelope procedures as specified in Public Procurement Act and Regulation.
- 2. Under the Single Stage, Two Envelope Procedure, Bidders are required to submit simultaneously two separate envelopes, one containing (i) the Technical Bid and the other (ii) the Price Bid, as per the provision of ITB 23 of the Bidding Document.
- 3. Eligible Bidders may obtain further information and inspect the bidding documents at the office of Armed Police Force, Nepal Headquarters, Procurement Division, Kathmandu, Tel 01-5249005, e-mail apfprocurement@gmail.com or may visit PPMO e-GP system www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp.
- 4. Bidder may download the bidding documents for e-submission from PPMO's e-GP system www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp. Bidders, submitting their bid electronically, should deposit the cost of bidding document Fee NRs.5,000/- in the following Rajaswa (revenue) account as specified below.

- Electronic bids must be submitted to the office of The Armed Police Force, Nepal Headquarters Procurement Division through PPMO's e-GP system <u>www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp</u> on or before 12:00 hrs. on, 11th Falgun, 2081. Bids received after this deadline will be rejected.
- 6. The bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 13:00 hrs on 11th Falgun, 2081 at the office of Armed Police Force, Nepal Headquarters, Procurement Division. Bids must be valid for a period of 90 days from the date of bid opening and must be accompanied by a scanned copy of the bid security in pdf format, amounting to a minimum NRs. 5,00,000/-. Which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid.
- 7. If the last date of purchasing and /or submission falls on a government holiday, then the next working day shall be considered as the last date. In such case the validity period of the bid and bid security shall remain the same as specified for the original last date of bid submission.
